

Turnpike Trails Pocket Guide

The trail network spans 9 miles across multiple parcels. The Fisher Hill Town Forest is owned by the Town of Francestown and managed by the Conservation Commission. The rest of the trails are on private property. Upper and Lower Turnpike Trails are on conservation land owned by Jim and Cindy St. Jean. The lower section of the Chasing Cars trail crosses property owned by the Francestown Land Trust.

- No Dogs or Horses Allowed
- E-bikes allowed by permission only
- Be respectful of private property and other trail users
- Please avoid using wet trails such as after heavy rain or in early spring
- Do not change, modify, or add trails

6 miles Putnam Loop → Perimeter Trail → Putnam Loop
Connector → Road to Nowhere → Driver's Seat
